# Acceptable Use of Funding

## Guidance for Completing LDCP Project Charter, Section 6.0

Funds must be applied towards the direct costs of the project for which they are awarded. The table below highlights some acceptable uses of LDCP funding. PHO reserves the right to modify and/or add non-eligible items at any time through the tenure of the award.

<b>Materials &amp; Supplies</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Office supplies, printing and photocopying</li> <li>• Data analysis software, such as NVivo, SPSS, or SAS</li> <li>• Computers, printers, and USB keys</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Standard monthly connection, rental for telephones, internet, or long distance fees</li> <li>• Cell phones and smartphone devices</li> <li>• Extended warranty for equipment</li> <li>• Cost of construction, renovation or rental of laboratories or supporting facilities</li> </ul>
<b>Services</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Transcription fees</li> <li>• Costs associated with professional report layout, design, and production</li> <li>• Independent consultant services</li> </ul>	

Description	Eligible Project Expenses	Non-eligible Project Expenses
<b>Activities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cost of networking or meeting activities, including collaboration, planning and exchange activities directly related to the team’s project, and extra travel funds required for members and trainees separated by significant distance</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Costs related to commuting between residence and place of employment</li> </ul>
<b>Knowledge Exchange Costs</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Conference registration fees</li> <li>• Print or online material</li> <li>• Manuscript submission fees</li> <li>• Translation fees</li> <li>• Knowledge user engagement strategy</li> <li>• Educational sessions or forums</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cost of entertainment, hospitality and gifts</li> <li>• Costs of attending conferences (e.g., travel, accommodation, meal stipends, etc.)</li> </ul>
